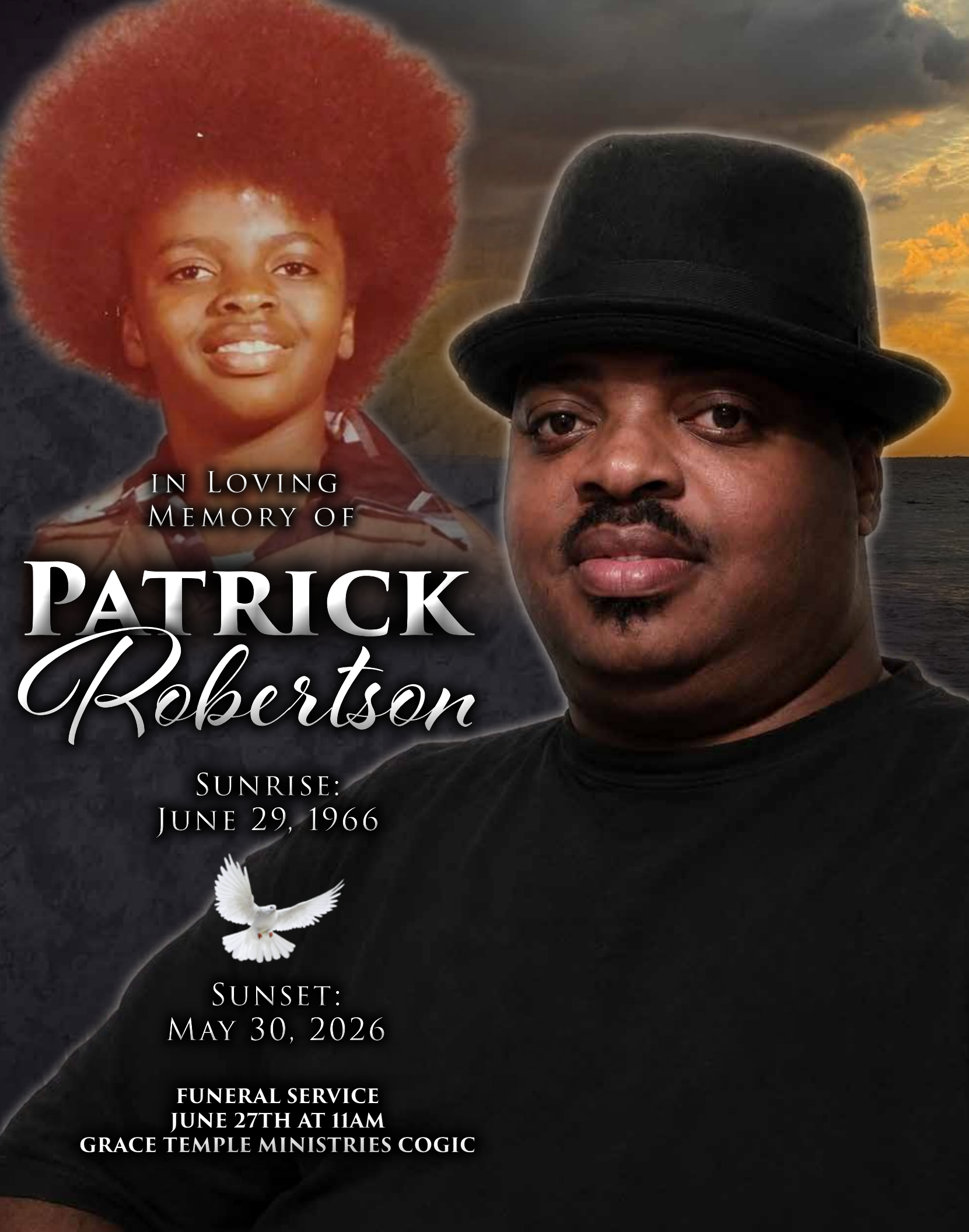

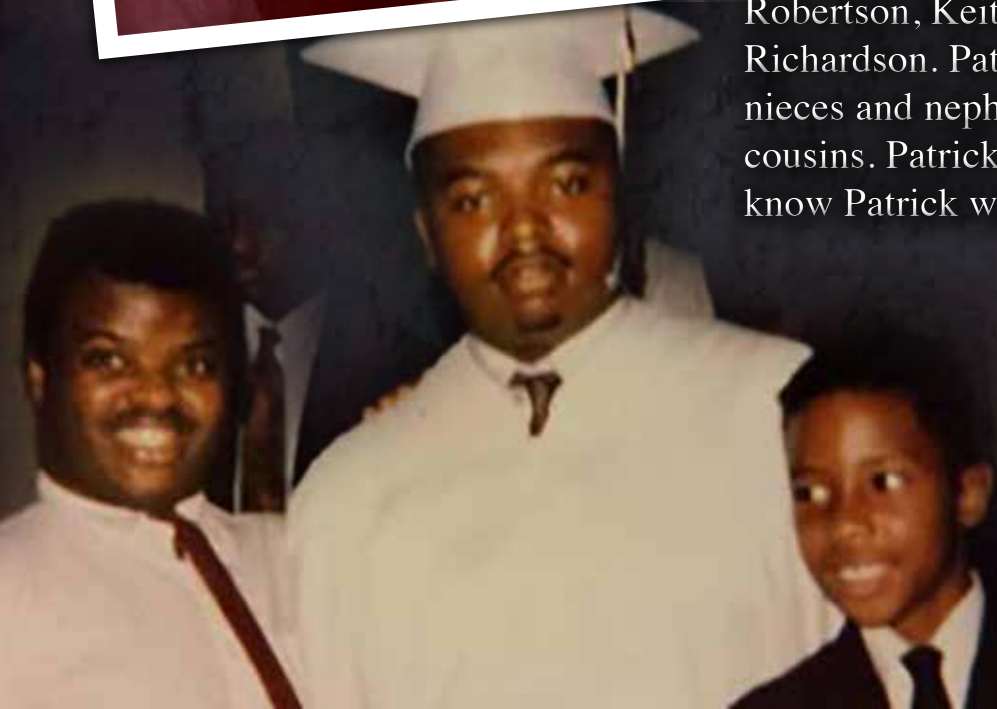


The Life of PATRICK ROBERSTON
